Fuller explained that NRICD is budgeting \$300/month per employee, using Peoplekeep an qualified small employer health reimbursement arrangement (QSEHRA). Steve Shuster explained Peoplekeep based on his conversation with Peoplekeep. Steve then explained how Brewster & Shuster works with clients to access a variety of markets and plans.

KK made a motion to allocated SRICD Board to vote to authorize employee health benefit options in the amount of \$300 per month per full time employee. PM 3-0
